
In normal environments in the UK, and given proper maintenance, Colourcoat can have a life expectancy on the weatherside of over 40 years. 
Fire Properties

Manufactured from steel, all profiles are designated as AA to B.S.476 Part 3 thereby deemed to satisfy provisions of The Building Regulations 1985 Approved Document B, Appendix A, Table A4 Part II.

Profile sheets are also designated as Class O to The Building Regulations by virtue of tests to 8.5.476 Part 6 (1>12;1>6) combined with a Class 1 surface spread of flame to 8.5.476 Part 7

3 " CORRUGATED SHEETING



Sheets available from up to 12m

3" Corrugated Sheeting is avalible in the same range as our box profile, Galvanized, Polyester and the Plastisol (PVC) Leather Grain finish.

We offer this in 1m cover and 763mm cover. However the 1m cover is only available in lengths up to 12ft 6" long.

The 763mm cover can be rolled in any length ranging from 1m up to 12m long. The corrugated has a more agricultural feel to it and is commonly used in the farming industry and the fencing industry.

A large amount of 3" corrugated steel profile sheets and GRP roof lights are constantly kept in stock in lengths up to 24ft/7.3m. Standard lengths are 6ft, 8ft, 10ft and 12ft but can be manufactured to suit too. All roof lights can be cut to exact length.

When fitting our 3" corrugated the fixing is to be put through the top of the profile with one of our self tapping tek screws which has a water sealant washer. The standard length of the fixing should be approx 45mm to allow for the profile of the sheet and then to allow a solid fix into the purlin whether that be timber, light metal or heavy metal.

ANTI-CONDENSATION BARRIER

The Phoenix Steels Anti-Condensation Membrane is a product designed to eliminate the problem of condensation. When the temperature and humidity conditions reach the dew point, the moisture condenses on the underside of the metal roof and forms droplets of water.

This membrane has many benefits from reducing the potential risk of damage to the contents of the building to protect animals and keeping them dry throughout the year. This is a more cost effective way of stopping condensation rather than insulating the roof with products such as a composite panel.

Roof lights are ideal for any project ranging from large agricultural buildings to small canopies.




The advantage of replacing some of the steel sheets with our GRP roof lights is that letting natural day light in creates saving in costs such as electricity.

For Existing Roofing Systems


The overclad system fully encapsulates the existing roof thus providing a waterproof solution without the inconvenience and cost of removing the original roof.

Single-skin and overclad installations are ideal in environments where minimal disruption to the business is required. Insulation is not compulsory for this if it is not required as you can simply use the mini z rail and top sheet only.
